On the first day of skiing, plan to arrive early – as early as 8:30 am – because it takes time to get everyone sorted and into their equipment and lessons. The first lessons are from 10:45 – 11:45 am, with a second lesson time being from 1:15 - 2:15 pm (if you can't arrive early.) Students may choose which time they will attend. On all five days, you can ski from 9am – 4pm (more than enough time to exhaust the energetic!)

## 5-week Ski Lesson Program

Ski Brule is offering an instructional ski program for anyone who is 10 years of age or older (including parents). It allows beginners to be introduced to the sport, and current skiers to improve their skills at a fantastic price. The program consists of 5 days of skiing and 4 days of lessons. Lessons for all levels of skiers and will be taught – right up to the most experienced! There are also excellent options for younger children, rather or not they wish to ski – so the entire family can come.

In addition, there is a great benefit available for those who drive students to the program. If you have a carpool of 5 or more students who are signed up for the program, you will get to ski free!! That's right – 5 students enrolled in the program earns the driver a free lift ticket, free rental, and even free lesson for each day of the program. If a group of parents will be taking turns driving the carpool, this benefit may be passed from parent to parent with each new day. If you need help forming a large-enough carpool, just contact our 5-week Ski Lesson organizer (Susan Lovig), and she will put you in contact with any students who are looking for rides.

Now, I'm Susan, and I don't work for SkiBrule. I'm a mom who wanted to organize a really great (and money-saving) way for my children to learn how to ski. And I must say, Ski Brule has been awesome at negotiating a great deal!

For our family, with 2 adults, 2 youth, and 2 children, skiing for **1 Sunday** with the Friends and Family discounts would cost \$152 for lift tickets, \$142 for equipment rentals, \$60 for two semi-private lessons for the youth and \$70 for the youngest two to have SKIwee lessons. That's \$424 for one day. That really hits our budget hard.

With the 5-week Ski Lesson Program that we've arranged, it looks more like this: One adult and 2 youth sign up for the Sunday program. Two children sign up for half-day lessons in SKIwee. This includes all of our rentals, lift tickets, and lesson costs – plus \$15 per day in free food at the cafeteria. Because we have 5 people signed up for the program, the other adult gets to **ski free** each day! For this, we pay \$135 per day, or \$675 total.

So, \$424 for one day of fun... or \$675 for 5 days of fun (+ \$75 in free food)!

This includes your ski rental and lift ticket and may be used by any registered driver for your group. **To sign up for this bonus, be sure to list all potential skiing drivers in the chart below.** Then, simply present yourself with your driver's license at the group window and Ski Brule will check you against the list of drivers for your group. \*My self-assigned role is to help riders find drivers, and drivers find riders. I will pass on your student's name and phone number to all drivers looking for riders, and I will provide you with all the names and phone numbers of those drivers as well. It is then up to the drivers and parents to decide whom the student will ride with, and to notify me of decisions made. I DO NOT assign positions or riders because I feel it is very important for the parents and drivers to have full say in who rides with whom. I also check over each form to ensure that checks are for the right amount, everything is signed, and all info is present – there will be no bumps in the road when your student arrives for their first day of skiing!

**I will confirm eligibility for free skiing with the driver(s)** as soon as each group is confirmed (all forms turned in/complete). **Remember – to claim free skiing as the driver, one adult from each group presents their driver's license to the group office each day.** I will provide Ski Brule with a list of approved drivers for each group, based on the charts submitted to me.
