

There are three ski patrol centers at Ski Brule. One on the front side (shown above), one at the base of the backside of the mountain & the third at the top of the mountain. A base radio is located at the front side patrol room so individuals can contact ski patrol themselves. Otherwise, any Ski Brule staff member can contact ski patrol for your group.

PLEASE Provide your Group Chaperone Contact Information at check in so we are able to contact you efficiently when needed. It is highly recommended to have a chaperone at the Brule Lodge during your visit or to provide Ski Brule with a radio to communicate directly with you. Cell phone service is sporadic at Ski Brule.

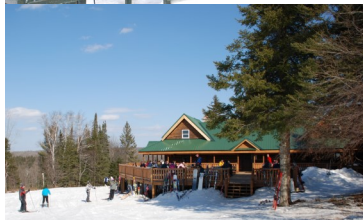
Special Groups: Bus is to park in the Rental Center parking lot. The group coordinator is to enter the Rental Center to advise of their arrival / make payment. The participants are to remain on the bus until a Ski Brule staff person arrives. The participants are to have their rental form and progress card in hand on the bus so it can be presented at the register when they enter the Rental Center.

Friday-Sun Groups, Holiday Groups & Saturday

Groups: Bus is to park in the 'Bus Unloading Area & Parking' lot. The group coordinator is to enter Guest Services (located lower level, hillside of Brule Lodge, across the street from parking) with all participant completed rental forms, participant counts and payment. The participants should remain on the bus until Group Coordinator returns from Guest Services. Guest Services will authorize all participant rental forms, issue lift tickets, meal vouchers, additional amenities and collect payment. Group Coordinator can then return to the bus and hand out tickets & rental forms to participants. Those that need rental equipment will then walk to the Rental Center. They can bypass the registers and go directly to equipment counters. Those that do not need rental equipment can head for the slopes.



Ski Brule provides a FREE ski & snowboard corral 8:30-4:15 on Saturday and Sunday.

When onsite, stop in at the Rental Center, Guest Service, Bear's Den Pro Shop or at the Lodging Office to call for the Village Shuttle Bus.

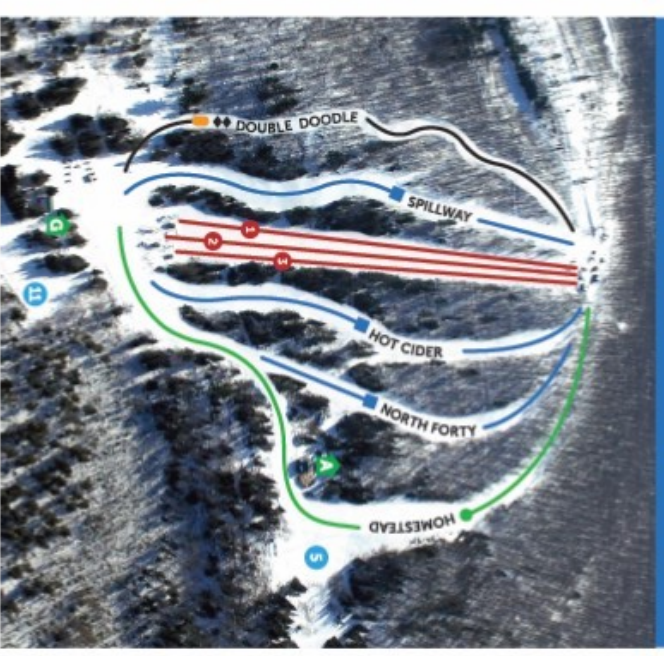
