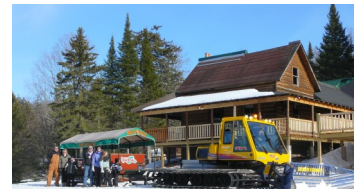
On Thursday and Saturday nights, Homestead Lodge features an "all you care to eat" barbecue

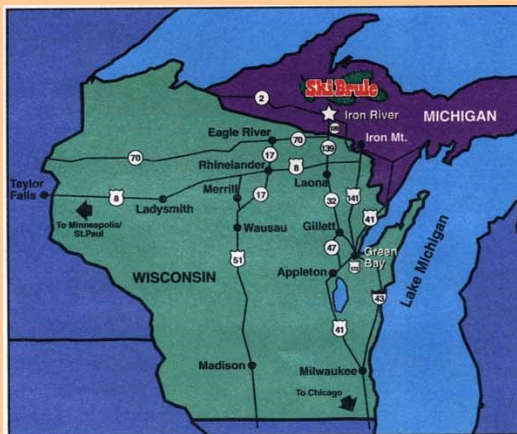

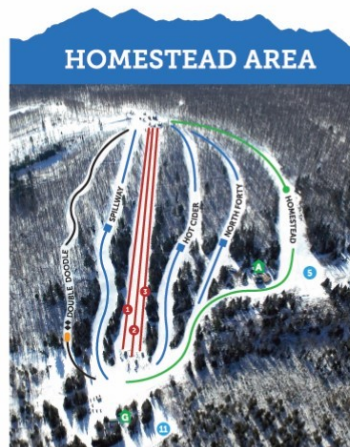
